

Mother Teresa

Mother Teresa was born Agnes Gonxha Bonjaxhiu in Skopje, Macedonia on August 27th, 1910. At the age of twelve she felt strongly about the call of God. She knew she would have to be a missionary to show and spread the love of Christ. At the age of eighteen she left her home in Skopje and joined the sisters of Loreto, who had missions in India.

After a few months training in Dublin she was to India, where on May 24th, 1931, she took her vows as a nun. From 1931 to 1948, Mother Teresa worked at St. Mary's high school in Calcutta. Mother Teresa had received permission from her superiors to leave the school, and devote herself to the poorest of the poor in the slums of Calcutta.

Although she had no money she depended on Divine Providence, and started a school for slum children.

She was born in 1910 and sadly died in 1997.
