Dear Sir or Madam

At the present time the Council are proposing to put into place Dog Control Orders within the East Riding of Yorkshire Council. One of these orders is in relation to the exclusion of dogs from specific sites. Our focus has been on sites controlled or owned by the Council where children are involved thus the proposal is to include in this order enclosed children's play areas and school sites.

The purpose of this e mail is to ascertain whether this course of action for school sites has the backing of you as head of the school. If it is felt that exclusion was not warranted then it would be feasible to apply an order where dogs have to be held on leads on the site if that was the consensus or not include your school at all.

If I do not receive a reply to this e mail by the 31 March 2009 then I will take it that you as head are happy with the proposal to exclude dogs from your particular site.
